Worship Team Handbook

Humans were created to worship God...literally, it's what we're made for! And God has called and gifted some of us to help lead His people in worship. It's an amazing calling! Here at Radiant Life, we strive to keep this calling as simple as possible. Here's how simple it is:

1. As we spend time with Jesus each week, we will worship.
2. As people see we are worshipping, they will worship.

Consider these verses:

Acts 4:13 Now when they saw the boldness of Peter and John, and perceived that they were uneducated and untrained men, they marveled. And they realized that they had been with Jesus.

Psalms 33:1-3 Rejoice in the Lord, O you righteous! For praise from the upright is beautiful. Praise the Lord with the harp; make melody to Him with an instrument of ten strings. Sing to Him a new song; play skillfully with a shout of joy.

Lifestyle Expectations

As believers in and followers of Jesus Christ, we're called to a standard of living that's different from this world; we're called to be set apart. In Philippians 2 we're encouraged to be 'like-minded, having the same love, being one in spirit and of one mind,' and to live in such a way that we 'will shine among them like stars in the sky as you hold firmly to the word of life.' **We take this call very seriously at Radiant Life.**

To be clear, we don't profess to be perfect. We all struggle with temptation and sin like everyone else. But we do hold ourselves, and this team, to a higher standard. Since we're given a platform that puts us in front of hundreds of people at any given service,

we have a greater responsibility to live the truth that is revealed in the Bible and held as a core belief of Radiant Life. Here are a few areas we expect each member of the worship team to strive and uphold together:

1. Sexual purity/integrity — We believe that sexual activity was created by God with the purpose of being expressed in a committed marriage relationship between one man and one woman. If you are married, it is expected that you are only having a sexual relationship with your spouse. If you are not married, it is expected that you are not having a sexual relationship with anyone.
2. Social Media — Ephesians 4:29 says, “Do not let any unwholesome talk come out of your mouths, but only what is helpful for building others up according to their needs, that it may benefit those who listen.” We expect our team to hold each other accountable on social media, that our words, our pictures, our opinions and our posts reflect that we are believers in and followers of Jesus Christ. We never want to cause others to stumble.
3. Mind-Altering Substances — Alcohol, prescription medicine, and marijuana are examples of substances that can alter your mind. We must be diligent as the Bible is clear that we need to avoid drunkenness and instead live a life of self-control, which is a fruit of the Spirit. Worship team members should not misuse alcohol, misuse prescription medicine, or use recreational marijuana. If you need some clarification on this, come talk to me. :-)
4. Attendance — The Radiant Life Worship Team is a family within a family. God wants you to be in fellowship APART from your service on the Worship Team. Attending church is a big part of fellowship. Serving on the team should be an act of love for Jesus. While watching the service online is awesome, we encourage team members to attend as many services as possible in person each month. Be a part of the family. Attending only when you’re serving shows a lack of spiritual health. Let’s talk. :-)
